## WHAT DOES Childre Nissan, Inc 126 Roberson Mill Rd Milledgeville, Ga 3106 DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Social Security number and <b>income</b></li> <li>■ <b>account balance</b> and <b>payment history</b></li> <li>■ <b>credit history</b> and <b>employment information</b></li> </ul> <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share <b>customers</b> personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their <b>customers</b> personal information; the reasons <b>Childre Nissan, Inc.</b> chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

**Who we are****Who is providing this notice?**

This notice is being provided by Childre Nissan and our partners.

**What we do****How does Childre Nissan, Inc. protect my personal information?**

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

**How does Childre Nissan, Inc. collect my personal information?**

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Apply for financing or Apply for lease
- Provide employment history or Give us your contact information
- Show us your driver's license

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

**Why can't I limit all sharing?**

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

**Definitions****Affiliates**

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

**Nonaffiliates**

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- Nonaffiliates we share with can include financial service providers (such as credit bureaus, manufacturer affiliated lenders, or other lenders), or they may be non-financial companies such as marketing companies or service providers.

**Joint marketing**

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- Our joint marketing partners may include the manufacturer affiliated lenders or other lenders.

**Other important information**

For purposes of this Privacy Policy, "Partner" shall mean any person or entity with whom we enter into any kind of business transaction who is under an obligation to us to use reasonable care to keep personal information confidential, which may include our affiliates, nonaffiliates, and those with whom we joint market.
